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WINE LIST

## White Wines

1. *Château de Mirande Mâcon Villages – French* ..... 36  
*Made from vines growing between the communes of Lugny and Viré, this wine is a perfect balance of roundness and intensity. Suffused with spicy, floral and fruity notes that linger pleasantly to the finish This wine pairs well with pasta, smoked salmon, Cheese and cured meats.*
2. *Hugel Gentil Alsace Riesling – French* ..... 34  
*Produced exclusively from hand-harvested grapes in predominantly, clay and limestone vineyards. This wonderfully complex wine is very aromatic, and fruit is driven with hints of spice on the finish. Perfect as an aperitif and paired with pork, Shellfish and Chicken.*
3. *Chateau Cassimichere Muscadet Sur Lie – French* ..... 34  
*Muscadet is a light-bodied, dry white wine made from Melon de Bourgogne grapes that impart lemon, lime, green apple and pear flavours. This wine is known for its dry mouth-watering freshness. Light in the body it finishes with crisp acidity.It pairs well with seafood.*
4. *Les Pierres Blanches Sancerre – French* ..... 51  
*The aromas express themselves through floral notes and hints of citrus. This pleasant, smooth wine possesses lingering fruity aromas. Dr Adams all-time favourite.*
5. *Les Champs de Cris Pouilly Fumé – French* ..... 51  
*Dry, crisp and mineral, with citrus and gooseberry flavours and a lovely finish.*
6. *Rift 71 Chardonnay IGP (Sulphite Free) – French* ..... 32.5  
*Typical and elegant nose with aromas of white flowers, butter and a gentle pepperiness. The mouth is generous and fresh with note of candied ginger.*
7. *Piedra del mar, Albariño – Spanish* ..... 33  
*On the palate, its vitality comes through in its fresh saltiness. On the nose mango, pineapple and lychee hints together with wildflowers, and balsamic notes of eucalyptus.*
8. *Viognier, Extrait de Romarion, Foncalieu, IGP Pays d'Oc (Languedoc), 2021 – French* ..... 29.5  
*The Viognier grape has an exotic fruit aroma and grapey-ness and is a bit different, and this lovely wine, made by the dynamic Foncalieu, is mouth-wateringly delicious and is really easy to enjoy by itself or with lighter foods. A delicious example of proper Viognier!*

9. *Mayr Grüner Veltliner – Austrian* ..... 35.5  
*Grüner Veltliner is Austria's signature grape. Fresh and zesty, it's the liquid equivalent of some cool Austrian mountain air. This wine is dry and unoaked with intense citrus flavours with green apples and spicy undertones.*
10. *Escapada Vinho Verde – Portugal* ..... 29  
*Vinho Verde is a widely consumed white wine from Northern Portugal. The wine tends to be made from local grapes. Vinho Verde is a light, refreshing wine with lots of floral and green fruit notes. The wine often has a slight carbonation to it, though not enough that it could be referred to as a sparkling wine.*
11. *Lyrarakis Assyrtiko – Greek* ..... 32.5  
*Established in 1966, It is located in the mountainous commune of Alagni (440 metres above sea-level), south of the city of Heraklion, in Crete. Aromas of stone fruit with delicate notes of ginger. Marvellously rich grapes have given this wine a generous mouthfeel balanced by a backbone of lean minerality.*
12. *Frescobaldi Pomino Bianco DOC – Italian* ..... 39  
*White flowers, green apple, pears, and grapefruit, giving way, to an extremely well-balanced nose. It is pleasantly fresh yet soft. A long and persistent finish.*
13. *Petit Chablis, Domaine des Anges, 2021* ..... 42  
*Made by the famous winemaker Séguinot-Bordet, this is a classic very dry Chablis. Fresh fruit, with further potential to age over the next three years. A great introduction to decent Chablis – full stop.*
14. *St. Clair Vicars Choice Sauvignon Blanc – New Zealand* ..... 31  
*A lifted nose shows aromas of gooseberry, grapefruit and passionfruit with refreshing underlying herbal notes. A pleasing mineral note leads to a long lingering finish.*
15. *Mooisplaas Chenin Blanc Bush vines – South African* ..... 34  
*Lovely straw colour nose, decidedly tropical with litchi, mango and summer melon flavours, good weight and balance on the palate, and lovely minerality.*
16. *Roisin Curley St Romain – French* ..... 120  
*This is a fantastic White Burgundy made by a Mayo native, Roisin Curley in the heart of France. Rich and rounded, this wine is an absolute treat.*
17. *Wild yeast Chardonnay – South African* ..... 35.5  
*Springfield Wild Yeast Chardonnay in the Western Cape region is a creamy white wine with rich aromas of white and tropical fruits. On the palate, it is complex, fresh and well-balanced. A fruity, elegant and flavoursome wine right to the end.*

18. Rully, Les Villeranges, Domaine Faiveley, 2020 – French ..... 75  
*The highly reputed house of Faiveley is one of Burgundy's best and most reliable winemakers. This Superior wine from the village of Rully is really very elegant and has a lovely complexity of fresh mineral flavors backed by a light oaking. Not expensive for such a very high quality – and absolutely delicious!*

## Red Wines

19. Matsu Picaro – Spanish ..... 29  
*The intense aroma of dark fruits such as blackberries and blueberries, and mineral notes appear creating a fresh wine with great complexity.*
20. Louis Max Fleurie – French ..... 36  
*Maison Louis Max has been passionately producing the fine wines of Burgundy since 1859. Floral and perfumed with a lovely light honey taste balanced with refreshing acidity. Well-balanced and fresh, it is an easy to drink wine, with smooth tannins and a long finish.*
21. Morgon, Corcelette, Comte Philippe de la Poype (Beaujolais) – French ..... 36.5  
*A favourite red: juicy and silky in texture, this is a seriously understated wine made from Gamay. Corcelette is one of the 6 best "climats" of the Morgon appellation. This is no ordinary Morgon - it has sensational quality and value and is a revelation.*
22. Shottesbrooke Shiraz – French ..... 28  
*With premium fruit sourced from carefully selected sites around McLaren Vale and the Adelaide Hills, the Estate Series proudly displays the fusion of hands-on vineyard practices with the passion they have for making wines of character and depth, whilst remaining true to the hallmark Shottesbrooke style of elegance and finesse. Elegant, rich and fully flavoured, the palate shows some initial fruit sweetness with nuances of dark chocolate.*
23. Côtes du Rhône, La Cueillette, Domaine Patrice Magni (Rhône) – French ..... 36.5  
*Patrice Magni cultivates seven hectares of 60-year-old Grenache and 40-year-old Syrah in Châteauneuf du Pape. His wines are smooth and full of fruit with some of the typical Rhône spicinesses behind - and all grown, within just a few metres of the world-famous Château de Beaucastel! Understated quality at a good price.*
24. Olivier Ravoire Vacqueyras – French ..... 39  
*A nice light southern Rhone wine. Potent mouthfeel, supple with melted tannins, characterised by a pleasant aromatic persistence. Intense nose with aromas of red and wild fruits.*

25. *Beaujolais Village, Louis Jadot* ..... 38  
*Spicy and a touch of liquorice, well balanced with a nice acidity. The wine is matured in stainless steel vats so that it may improve while keeping all its fruit. Tasting notes it has a very deep ruby-red colour. The nose is fresh with delicate and typical fruit: black fruit and blossom including iris. It has a very good fat and tannic body on the palate.*
26. *Lyrarakis Kotsfali – Greek* ..... 32.5  
*The red grape variety Kotsifali is indisputably a classic of the vineyards of Crete. Spices and red fruits with an elegant mouthfeel and a piquant aftertaste are the characteristics of the wine which is produced from vineyards situated at 500m. altitude.*
27. *Post House Missing Virgin – South Africa* ..... 39  
*From the Stellenbosch region in Western Cape, this is an amazing, full-bodied, rich wine with supple and soft tannins and a hint of blueberries. It is one of our favourites and goes well with beef, venison and poultry.*
28. *Château Bégadan, Médoc (Bordeaux) – French* ..... 39  
*This is phenomenal – it's delicious and it's such good value! A regular medal-winning Bordeaux made from 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% Merlot, resulting in a richer fruity oaky style of Médoc that should remain, great to enjoy by itself. Even better when served with lamb or richer-flavoured red meats.*
29. *Castiglioni Chianti – Italian* ..... 36  
*Chianti is nestled within the larger wine region of Tuscan. Cherry, blackcurrant and raspberry notes on the nose. On the palate, Chianti Castiglioni is lively, soft and enveloping. The finish is long and persistent, with the aftertaste confirming the fruity aromas previously, detected on the nose.*
30. *Côte de Nuits Villages, Les Retraits, Domaine Boursot  
 Père & Fils (Burgundy) 2018* ..... 75  
*This is an understated wine, coming from Comblanchien, just beside "Clos de la Maréchale", one of Nuits Saint Georges' greatest Premier Crus. The wine has the style of a great Burgundy – full of Pinot fruit with body. This wine can be enjoyed now but it can also keep another couple of years.*
31. *Masi Campofiorin – Italian* ..... 36  
*A beautiful wine from Northern Italy. Campofiorin is full-bodied, smooth and velvety, combining style and strength, rich intense cherry and sweet spices on the long length. We think this Northern Italy Red wine would be a match made in heaven with Beef, Pasta, Lamb and Game.*
32. *Château Tour de Pressac, Grand Cru Saint-Emilion (Bordeaux) 2016* ..... 62  
*Made from younger vines at the great Château Pressac, Grand Cru Classé in the prime Saint-Etienne de Lisse area of Saint-Emilion. This delightful wine is soft, rich and round and works well with chicken or lighter red meats.*

33. *Post House Blueish Black Shiraz/Pinotage/Merlot – South Africa* ..... 29  
*The name refers to the colour of the wine which has a dark blue tinge to the wine. A well-balanced, rich wine with supple soft tannins for easy drinking. A nose of mulberries, red currant and ripe strawberries with a hint of pepper and spice.*
34. *Chateau Tayac, Margaux – French* ..... 74  
*Bordeaux Margaux wines tend to be deep ruby in colour, perfumed and floral, particularly with notes of violets and lilacs, and soft, silky tannins. Less masculine and powerful than wines from other regions of Bordeaux, Margaux wines are typically more refined and elegant. Fresh and Plummy, warm and soft with a good core of fruit.*
35. *Kanonkop Kadette – South African* ..... 32  
*Kanonkop in Stellenbosch is one of South Africa's most prestigious estates, bottling its first wines in 1973. This wine is a unique blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Pinotage which is given oak ageing.*
36. *Seifried Pinot Noir– New Zealand* ..... 33  
*Succulent with dark berry fruits. Strong, rich blackberry and cinnamon flavours linger and leave a long lasting impression on the palate.*

## Natural and Organic Wines

37. *Sifer Wines – Ephraim 20 (Red)* ..... 46  
*A wonderfully well-made Garnacha from this generational family bodega in Terra Alta. Red and black fruit and berries on the nose with delicate notes of herb and earth. Round and balanced in the mouth with a satisfying finish.*
38. *Sifer Wines – Ephraim Rose 21 (Rose)* ..... 45  
*Garnacha Rosé with bright notes of crushed berries - cranberries and raspberries, with light tannins and fruity acidity combined in this sapid and refreshing rosé/light red - serve chilled.*
39. *Where Black is the color where none is the number – Les Bories Jefferies – Red* 72  
*Jo is from Warwickshire originally, but settled in France many years ago and has been tending his father in laws vines in the tiny village of Caux in the Languedoc for the past decade. This magnificent Carignan, blended with a little grenache and grenache gris, comes from vines growing on volcanic soils deep in the south, with the ripeness of fruit that is typical of the south, but nuance and freshness that speaks to the old basalt soils these vines grow on.*
40. *Sifer Wines – Vibria 20 (White)* ..... 40  
*Macabeu - Intense and vegetal on the nose with white flowers and earth. A savoury acidity follows with mineral freshness and a bright finish. Sifer wines are based in Calaceite, Catalunya, Spain*
41. *A Toi Nous 21 – Domaine Andrea Calek – Valvignères, Ardèche, France (Red)* 43  
*A bright, red-fruited blend of Syrah and grenache with most of the wine coming from direct press juice. Raspberries and herbs with earthy notes and signature fluidity. Served Chilled.*

**42. Blanc sense Papers 21 (White)** ..... 55  
*Xarello from a single vineyard growing in the Penedès in Catalunya. Ferran harvests this over three passes, vinifying each harvest separately before blending to achieve a delicate, layered expression of this intriguing variety, offering both complexity and refreshment. Really wonderful wine from a very exciting producer in Catalunya*

## Sparkling & Champagne

**43. Moët & Chandon Brut** ..... 80  
*The legendary Moët & Chandon is celebrating 270 years as one of the world's most-loved champagne. Bright fruitiness, seductive palate, and elegant maturity are how the world's most loved Champagne is described!*

**44. Pannier Brut** ..... 90  
*In 1899, Louis-Eugène Pannier began the story of Champagne Pannier in Dizi, just outside Epernay. Freshly baked brioche and apple pastry, with a lingering yeasty citrus finish reminiscent of a lemon tart. Medium-bodied with a refreshing mouthfeel and beautiful lively mousse.*

**45. Richard-Dhondt, Cuvée de Réserve, Brut Champagne** ..... 70  
*This amazing champagne is made by a small Premier Cru and Grand Cru grower in the prime village of Dizi just outside Epernay. It's made from equal percentages of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay, with 50% reserve (older) wine and then aged for a minimum of 18 months, giving soft fruity but toasty flavours. This has good quality and a smart label, reminiscent of Bollinger RD*

**46. Veuve Clicquot** ..... 120  
*This champagne stands out for its beautiful harmony, its large structure, its freshness and its intense fruity aromas. Yellow colour with golden sparkles and tiny bubbles. Intense and pleasant. Its notes of fruit and brioche are wrapped in aromas of nuts. Perfect balance between the freshness of the fruit and some toasted and vanilla aromas.*

**47. Bollinger Special Cuvee** ..... 120  
*Since 1829, Champagne Bollinger has been making great wines with a powerful, refined and complex style, expressing the aromas of the fruit in all its dimensions. Aromas of elegant, creamy citrus fruits. Well-structured with citrus and orchard fruits, impeccable acidity and a lingering finish.*

**48. Masottina, Conegliano, Valdobbiadene Superiore Spumante D.O.C.G.** ..... 44  
*Intense fruity aromas of apple, lemon and grapefruit are balanced by flowers. Full-bodied with good acidity on the palate and fresh flavours.*

Snipe Bottle

49. *Colle del Principe Prosecco* ..... 8.5 34  
*A beautiful, somewhat less popular, and often less expensive compared to Champagne, Prosecco is a deliciously dry sparkling wine with crisp acidity, low sugar, with plenty of fruit and character. Fresh, harmonious and well-structured, with distinct aromas of fruits and flowers.*

## Non Alcoholic Wines

Glass Bottle

50. *Natura de-alcoholised Classic White* ..... 5.5 18  
*Crisp and refreshing with tropical fruit flavours and an integrated palate. Versatile, health-conscious and delicious. Low in calories and vegan-friendly.*
51. *Natura de-alcoholised Classic Red* ..... 5.5 18  
*Red berries and sweet spice intrigue and follow through for a smooth mouthfeel and lingering aftertaste.*

## House White

Glass Bottle

52. *Azur, Vin de France, Domaine Bassac (Languedoc), 2021 ORGANIC* .... 8 29  
*This organic wine ticks all the right boxes and is just so moreish. Made from an enticing blend, of Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Grenache Blanc and Muscat so it is fresh, grapey and dry with a little bit of spiciness – easy to enjoy by itself and excellent with food.*
53. *Pinot Grigio, Ca’Stellor (Italy)* ..... 7.5 27  
*This delicious Pinot Grigio is full of flavours with bright notes of honey, apple and wildflowers. It is a fresh, clean and lively wine with a pleasant aftertaste.*
54. *L’Infini Chardonnay, Domaine du Paradis (Languedoc), 2022* ..... 8 29.5  
*A light Chardonnay that is fresh and fruity. If people think they don’t like Chardonnay, they should be, pleasantly surprised by this! From the talented Jonquères d’Oriola winemaking family at Château de Corneilla just outside Perpignan.*
55. *Sauvignon Blanc Reserve St Jacques – French* ..... 7.5 28  
*A crisp Sauvignon Blanc with mouth watering balance. Packed with ‘green’ citrus flavours and a tingly, stony palate.*

## House Rose

56. *Azur, Vin de France, Domaine Bassac (Languedoc), 2021 ORGANIC* ..... 28  
*A dry rosé with plenty of flavours, being made primarily from Cinsault, Syrah and Grenache. Mid-colour and delicious.*

57. *La Chevaliere Rose (France)*  
*Ripe redcurrant and strawberry aromas on the nose. Delicate fruitiness on the palate, ... 7 28.5*  
*combined with a lively acidity and a juicy, refreshing finish.*

## House Red

Glass Bottle

58. *Merlot, Alvier (Chile)* ..... 6.5 25  
*Smooth, complex, well-rounded with soft tannins that provide a long and pleasant finish. Black ripe fruits, plums and cherries notes.*

59. *Cabernet Sauvignon, Les Jamelles – French* ..... 7 26  
*With a beautiful dark red colour, the Cabernet-Sauvignon Les Jamelles reveals aromas of red fruits (blackcurrant, strawberry), combined with a light vegetal note full of freshness (green pepper, characteristic of the grape variety) and spicy flavours (cinnamon, mint, honey). Its finish is subtly woody (with aromas of cedar, oak, and nuts). The tannins are supple and silky.*

60. *Muriel Rioja Reserva – Spanish* ..... 8 32  
*The Muriel Reserva is a red wine from the La Rioja region of Spain. The wine is allowed ferment for 15 days before being left to age for 24 months. A finely balanced wine, with a polished and elegant body, and a long and pleasant aftertaste.*

61. *Malbec OPI Argentina* ..... 7.5 28  
*Purple in colour. The nose offers minerals, plums and black cherry notes with a touch of black pepper. The palate is soft with sweet tannins with ripe, saturated berry flavours.*

### HALF BOTTLE

62. *Beaujolais Village, Louis Jadot (Red) – French* ..... 20  
*Spicy and a touch of liquorice, well balanced with a nice acidity. The wine is matured in stainless steel vats so that it may improve while keeping all its fruit. Tasting notes It has a very deep ruby-red colour. The nose is fresh with delicate and typical fruit: black fruit and blossom including iris. It has a very good fat and tannic body on the palate.*

## HALF BOTTLE

63. *Sauvignon Blanc, Torréon Andes Collection (White)* ..... 16  
*Crisp with a well-balanced acidity that lends a nice and long finish. Fruity on the nose with delicate notes of lemon peel.*

## Dessert Wine

64. *Sweet Agnes Riesling – New Zealand* ..... 35  
*Luscious sweet Riesling from the pioneering Seifried estate in Nelson, just next door to Marlborough. The region boasts 2,400 hours of sunshine a year, bringing amazing intensity and complexity to this fabulous, double-Gold, rich, honeyed white. Intensely rich, fruity and sweet yet remarkably fresh and vibrant. Giving a Lemon sherbet, orange marmalade, tropical fruits and butterscotch aroma. Perfect for after Dinner!!!*



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
